CEIOPS is pleased to invite you to its 4th Annual Conference that will take place on 19 November 2008 in Frankfurt am Main (Germany).



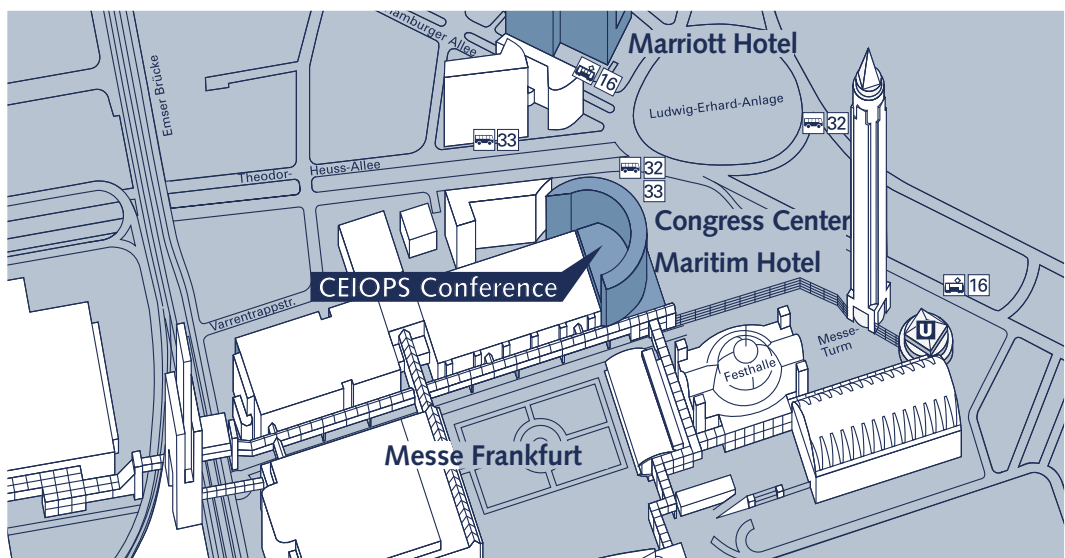
